



Many Point Scout Camp Centennial Scholarship

Many Point recognizes the importance of older Scouts attending camp as youth leaders for their troop or crew. As a means to recognize these active youth role models, we are offering two scholarship awards for those who will be pursuing post-secondary education.

Application Deadline: Applications must be received by October 1, 2010

Requirements – All applicants must:

- Be currently registered with a troop or crew in the Boy Scouts of America.
- Have attended Many Point for a full week as a **youth** member of a troop, crew or post during the summer of **2010**. Applicant's name must be present on the unit's camp roster.
- Have completed his or her junior year of high school.
- Be pursuing post-secondary education (college, technical or vocational school) immediately after graduation from high school. Proof of enrollment will be required before the scholarship check is mailed to the educational institution.
- Have demonstrated strong leadership and commitment to troop or crew.
- Provide one signed recommendation letter from a volunteer Scout leader or a professional Scouter who knows the applicant personally. Please submit only one recommendation.
- Attach an essay of 500 words or less in response to the following question, "How has your Scouting experience **at Many Point** shaped your character?"

Procedures

- Complete the application.
- Enclose only the items requested in the requirements.
- Answer all questions on the application ("See Attached" is not an acceptable answer).
- Include the applicant's name on each enclosure in the upper right hand corner.
- Submit all supplemental information with the application forms to ensure that all items are available for review at the same time (Many Point will not match items that come in separately).

- Applications must be received by October 1, 2010.
- Be advised that the applications become property of the selections committee and will not be returned to the applicant. Portions of the essays may be used in camp promotional materials.
- Two scholarships of \$300.00 each will be awarded.
- The selections committee will notify applicants by December 1, 2010.
