Older Scout Flintlock Program Request Form

Purpose of Flintlock

Flintlock programs offer more challenge and variety to the experienced camper, giving them something new and exciting to look forward to each year. Therefore, Flintlock programs are designed for and require that participants are entering at least 8th grade in the upcoming school year.

How to Fill Out this Request Form

Some of the programs are very popular and have a limited number of spaces each week. It is possible that not all requests can be accommodated. Completing the form using the directions described below will increase the likelihood that your Scouts will get their top priorities for Flintlock activities.

1. Print troop number and campsite at the top of the form.
2. Print the names of the Scouts in the left column.
3. Fill in the number of years that each Scout has been at camp.
4. Rank each Scout's first program choice by writing a '1' in the appropriate column. (1 = highest priority)
5. Rank each Scout's second program choice by writing a '2' in the appropriate column.
6. Rank each Scout's third program choice by writing a '3' in the appropriate column.
7. Continue ranking for each of the programs that your Scouts would like to attend.
8. The Scoutmaster should sign and date the bottom of the form.

'NO SHOW' Policies

Many programs have a limited size or need a minimum number of participants to be held. Scouts should only sign up for programs in which they intend to participate. If a Scout signs up but does not show up, it keeps other interested Scouts from participating or forces the cancellation of some programs (you can't do a trust fall in COPE with only half of the catchers). To emphasize this, camp has a "no show" charge of \$5.00 per Scout that does not attend a confirmed program.

General Information

- Troops are responsible for transportation to and from the Flintlock Lodge, where most of these programs are held.
- Flintlock programs are intended and designed for Scouts only.
- The following should be brought to each program:

COPE

long pants & closed-toe shoes = required, water bottle & bug repellent

Kayak Programs*

swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, sunglasses, water bottle (overnight = add sleeping bag & change of clothes)

Huck Finn*

swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, water bottle, rain gear & bug repellent (overnight = add sleeping bag & change of clothes)

Sailing & Sailboards*

swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, water bottle & bug repellent

Tree House

sleeping bag, change of clothes, water bottle, rain gear & bug repellent

Challenge Outpost*

swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, water bottle, bug repellent, change of clothes – Scouts will not be in swimsuits all day

Target Sports Outpost

water bottle & bug repellent

*these programs require Scouts to be qualified as Swimmers
